

ORDINANCE 2020-1053

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF MOUNT PLEASANT, TENNESSEE AS SET FORTH IN TITLE 19, CHAPTER 4 REGARDING AN UPDATE TO CURRENT GAS CODES.

WHEREAS, the codes establishing minimum standards the design and installation of fuel gas distribution piping and systems, appliances, appliance venting systems, combustion air provisions, gaseous hydrogen systems and motor vehicle gaseous-fuel-dispensing stations is adopted in Title 19, Chapter 4, *Gas System Rules and Regulations*, of the Municipal Code of the City of Mount Pleasant; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend said chapter in order to adopt new and improved fire standards to better protect the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MOUNT PLEASANT, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title 19, Chapter 4, *Gas System Rules and Regulations*, of the Mount Pleasant Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting Section 19-401, subsections (4) and (8) in their entirety and substituting the following, so that Section 19-401(4) and 19-401(8) shall read as follows:

19-401. Definitions.

(4) "Gas Code." The *International Fuel Gas Code*, 2018, edition, as amended, as published by the International Code Council.

(8) All definitions contained in the *International Fuel Gas Code*, 2018 edition, as amended, are hereby adopted by this chapter and when used herein, or in connection with the natural gas distribution system of the City of Mount Pleasant, Tennessee, shall apply.

Section 2. If any one or more of the provisions of this Ordinance, or any exhibit or attachment thereof, shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, by final decree of any court of lawful jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof, or of any exhibit or attachment thereto, but this Ordinance, and the exhibits and attachments thereof, shall be construed the same as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein, or therein, as the case may be.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage.
